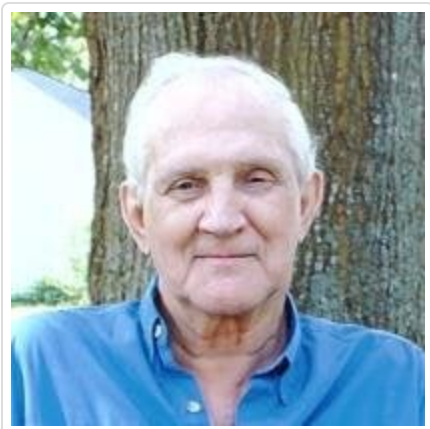




Bill F. Bruce
